The King's Academy and Fremont Union High School District Sign 25 Year Lease

“New Lease Enables Christ-centered College Preparatory, Grades 6-12, to Solidify Its Future”

SUNNYVALE, Calif, January 13, 2010 — The King's Academy has leased a portion of the former Sunnyvale High School site on the corner of E. Duane Avenue and N. Britton Avenue in Sunnyvale since 1993. The King's Academy (TKA) is a Christ-centered college preparatory school serving 880 students in grades 6-12. Yesterday, The Fremont Union High School District (FUHSD) agreed to extend the lease with The King's Academy from its current 10 year range to a lease covering 25 years.

“We are grateful for the support of the school district and the city of Sunnyvale which has made it possible for The King's Academy to thrive and serve more students and families at our current site for years to come,” remarked Jerry Bruce, TKA School Board member.

Several years ago, The King's Academy, which was founded in 1991, explored the possibility of acquiring a new location. After careful research and consideration, the school decided the most feasible and desirable path was to remain at the current site, seek a long-term lease, and substantially increase investment to improve the physical campus for future generations of TKA students. The school has recently added permanent lighting to the athletic fields, enabling nighttime practices and games. Negotiations with FUHSD began in December 2008.

This long-term relationship between The King's Academy and FUHSD serves the educational needs of local youth and is good news on many fronts. First, the relationship between FUHSD and The King's Academy has been strengthened through this process. Secondly, the long-term commitment expressed by TKA has allowed FUHSD to make stronger commitments to the upkeep of the campus. Numerous projects have been committed to by FUHSD, including seismic retrofits of some structures, re-roofing of all roofs as needed, and replacement of the gymnasium bleachers, in conjunction with TKA. Finally, and most importantly, this important milestone puts The King's Academy in a position to move forward with long-term development plans for the campus.

The King's Academy is a Christ-centered college preparatory middle and senior high school for students who have teachable hearts and coachable spirits. The school offers a loving, family environment where students are encouraged to grow in their relationship with Jesus, their family, teachers, and others. The King's Academy is accredited by both the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI) and The Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC).
