Certainly, academic preparation is key. The King's Academy tests all applicants to be sure students are performing at grade level or higher in order to handle the college prep level and pace of instruction. Once in high school, students who have demonstrated capability may select from many Honors and Advanced Placement (AP) Courses for further

academic challenge. At TKA, there is strong emphasis on skill building, in addition to content comprehension, so that students are equipped for college and work. They will learn and practice organization and study skills, critical thinking skills, effective oral and written communication skills, as well as collaboration and teamwork skills.

Additionally, at The King's Academy, we offer regular and numerous opportunities for service. Service allow students to discover the pleasure of helping others and what it feels like to participate in something larger than themselves.
