## NEW STUDENT FEES

*All fees below are non-refundable.*

**New Student Application Fee.....\$75**

**New Student Registration Fee ..... \$175**  
*Due within 2 weeks after acceptance*

## TUITION

Tuition may be paid by one of three plans:

### 1. Yearly (Due July 1, 2021)

	First Child	Additional Child
Grade 6	\$20,550	\$18,550
Grades 7-8	\$21,600	\$19,600
Grades 9-12	\$22,900	\$20,900

### 2. Semester

(Two payments due July 1, 2021 & December 1, 2021)

### 3. Monthly\*

The annual tuition may be paid in a total of eleven (11) payments due on the first of each month, July 2021 – May 2022. The approximate monthly amounts are listed below:

(\*Amounts shown reflect total annual tuition less \$1,000 tuition deposit)

- An Enrollment Packet between parents and TKA is required/due for returning or new students. This includes a tuition agreement along with payment of the enrollment fee. (\$175 new student registration plus \$1,000 tuition deposit)
- All families are required to be enrolled in FACTS Management for tuition and incidental (non-tuition) fee accounting. Note all payments must be made through FACTS.
- TKA has a financial aid program to assist families for whom full tuition is not affordable. An online application is located on TKA's website under "Admissions".

## TUITION DEPOSIT

*Deposit is non-refundable*

All Students ..... \$1,000\*  
Due Date..... March 1, 2021  
Late Fee..... 10% after March 15, 2021  
(\* deducted from annual tuition)

## PAYMENT POLICIES

- Once a new student has been accepted, enrollment fee must be submitted within two weeks.
- The first tuition payment is due by July 1, 2021 and is non-refundable. Tuition payments are due on the first of each month.
- A \$25 late fee is applied when tuition payments are not received by FACTS by the 10<sup>th</sup> of each month. A \$25 late fee is applied when any school fee is not received by its due date.
- Students may not be permitted to attend class if their tuition is more than 30 days late, unless prior arrangements have been made with the Business Office.

## PAYMENT POLICIES *(continued)*

- Exceptions to any of the tuition and fee policies will be made by written agreement with the Business Office.
- **Please contact the Business Office if a problem arises that affects your ability to make a payment.**

## FEES FOR VOLUNTARY PROGRAMS

### Academic and VPA Fees

Non-refundable fees apply for AP exams and summer school as well as for some Visual and Performing Arts (VPA) electives and extracurricular programs.

### Athletic Sports Fees

This non-refundable fee is due before the first league or “official” game, and is paid for each sport in which the student participates. Please see website (under “Admissions”) for details.

## SERVICE TRIP DONATIONS

TKA's annual service trips provide high school students a missions experience of serving families and communities in need. Trips within the U.S. and to Mexico cost from \$175-\$1,500, depending on the destination. Overseas trips range from \$1,650-\$2,900. Students are encouraged to fundraise to cover the expenses of these trips. Donations for all trips are tax-deductible and non-refundable.

## THE KNIGHTS ANNUAL FUND

The Knights Annual Fund supports our school by providing additional resources in two areas that are extremely critical to TKA's mission and excellence:
