This "Tale As Old As Time" is filled with magical costumes and memorable characters. Released in 1991, Disney's *Beauty and the Beast* became the first animated film to be nominated for the Academy Award for Best Picture, and in 1994, *Beauty and the Beast* became Disney's first animated film to be adapted into a Broadway musical. The music was written by Alan Menken, and the lyrics by Howard Ashman and Tim Rice. The play ran on Broadway for 5,461 performances until 2007 and was Broadway's eighth longest-running production in history.
