The King's Academy Celebrates Two Athletes Signing Division 1 and 2 College Offers

SUNNYVALE, CA, February 3, 2013 —

Zhipeng “Colin” Zeng (5’5”, 130 lbs) will sign February 5 to attend The Ohio State University’s diving team, an NCAA Division 1 team. Zeng has been named All American Diving Champion two times and the Central Coast Section (CCS) Diving Champion three times. The King’s Academy senior dives from all three boards: the 1 meter springboard, 3 meter springboard, and 10 meter platform. Colin came to TKA from Fujian province, Gutian county, People’s Republic of China. Colin states that what excites him about his sport “is the desire to honor and glorify God with the amazing talents that God gave me.” Colin also enjoys frisbee, baseball and basketball. He is a member of Peninsula Bible Church and has served with The King’s Academy in Kentucky with the Christian Appalachian Project and with City Impact in San Francisco. To prepare to compete, Colin prays, listens to music, and focuses on his breathing.

Luke Vereschagin (5’10” 185 lbs), The King’s Academy kicker/punter will sign February 5 with Azusa Pacific University, NCAA Division 2. Vereschagin has earned the following recognitions: First Team All-League, fourth place National Kicking Competition Scholarship Division in 2013, and achieved the school record for kick-off long (76 yards) and punt (57 yards). What excites him most about football is “going to battle with your brothers, warriors, and fighting for something greater than yourself: God’s glory.” “Every time I line up a kick, I block out all distractions and say ‘For your glory Father,’ and go!” In addition to football, Vereschagin has exemplified leadership, hard work, and strong character throughout his high school career, serving as Student Council President and also as a worship leader at both TKA and Westgate Church.

The King’s Academy will hold a signing celebration on Wednesday, February 5, at 12:10 p.m. in the Paul M. Spates Memorial Gymnasium on the school’s campus. The King’s Academy community is invited to attend.
