### ACADEMIC & COLLEGE COUNSELING

Four full-time counselors offer comprehensive academic and college planning programs for students and parents beginning in the 9th grade. During junior year, each student is assigned a personal college counselor who remains with the student through the senior year.

### SERVICE

- 35 hours/year (140 total hours) community service required of high school students in order to graduate.

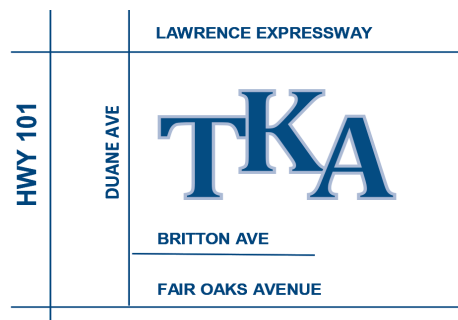
### ATHLETICS
