



Tecate Advanced Ministry Team (A-Team): March 22-30, 2018

Mission

In Matthew 28 we are given The Great Commission to go and make disciples of all nations. This calling is squarely at the heart of the Tecate service trip. Goals

- To give a group of young men the opportunity to grow through servant leadership
- To provide logistical support to the effective running of the Mexico service trip

Itinerary

Thursday, March 22	Travel to San Diego. Stay overnight in a hotel.
Friday, March 23	Drive to Tecate, unload trucks, set up camp.
Saturday, March 24	Prepare camp for the arrival of caravans.
March 25-28	Work on sites, run outreaches
Thursday, March 29	Tear down camp and load up trucks. Last to leave camp, cross the border, stay overnight in the Grapevine area.
Friday, March 30	Arrive back at TKA in early afternoon, help unpack the trucks.

Pre-Trip Training

Team members will be expected to attend 3-4 lunch meetings. Additionally, they will help with preparation of tents, coolers, and other supplies during lunch hours and after school on occasion as the trip approaches. Please note that A-Team members will be required to help early in the morning of Tuesday, March 20 with the Luggage Drop-Off for the Tecate Trip.

Accommodations/Food

After spending Thursday night in a hotel near the San Diego border, A-Team crosses over into Mexico and stays at the Ranch in Tecate Friday night through Wednesday night. Leaving on Thursday morning after the camp is torn down, A-Team travels further than the caravans and stays in a hotel Thursday night near the Grapevine area.

Cost - \$700

There is no additional cost to participate in A-Team; the cost for the trip is the same as the cost for the Tecate trip.



Application Process

To apply, please submit the Tecate Ministry Team Application. The link to this application will be posted on the Student Portal under the “Alerts” section in the upper-right corner. Applications will only be accepted during the following time frame: Friday, August 25, 12:00 p.m. through Friday, October 13. The Tecate Ministry Team Application is for current full-time students only. All applicants will still also need to complete the Tecate Trip Registration (a separate form) which will be available online October 20-27.

Selection Process

The team will consist of 40 students and at least 12 adult leaders. After applications are submitted, all applicants will be interviewed and selected based upon the following criteria: willingness to work in a team setting and think of others first, even in uncomfortable situations; desire to serve God wholeheartedly; commitment to make the Tecate trip as comfortable as possible for others; and cross-cultural sensitivity. The Tecate A-Team will weigh grade level in the selection process, with consideration given to seniors. All applicants will be interviewed; interviews will be held between September 6 and October 19. Students selected will be notified by October 20, 2017.
