



Kentucky Service Trip: April 4-10, 2020

Mission

All interested 11th and 12th grade students are encouraged to apply for the 2020 Kentucky Service Trip. Up to 20 inspired and qualified students, along with 8 adults, will fly to Kentucky and partner with the Christian Appalachian Project (CAP) to assist families living in poverty in the eastern part of the state. We will travel in groups of 7 each day (2 adults and 5 students) from our camp to do construction projects, landscaping, painting, cleaning; anything to proactively help those families in need.

Goals

We want to deepen our personal relationship with our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ through the process of serving. We desire also to draw closer to one another in Christ. With those two precepts as a foundation for our ministry, we feel we can truly bless those we meet and be genuinely blessed as well. This will be our 11th amazing year travelling to the gentle, genuine state of Kentucky.

Itinerary

- April 4 Leave Bay Area and fly to Kentucky
 Drive rental vans to the camp and check-in
- April 5 Free time at camp or nearby town, orientation followed by night-time devotions
- April 6-8 Minister at work sites 9:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. Dinner, devotions, free time.
- April 9 Minister at work sites 9:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.
 Evening activity includes bluegrass band and worship night with families at camp.
- April 10 Leave camp in the morning, drive vans to Louisville airport. Return to Bay Area.

Housing

We will be staying at a Christian Appalachian Project's facility. The center has separate boys and girls dormitories with full bathrooms. Meals are provided, except when travelling to and from airports.

Food

All meals (breakfast, sack lunch, dinner) are provided by our host, Christian Appalachian Project, on work days. On travel days, we are responsible for our lunch and dinner. On the return trip, we eat our own meals on the road as well. Kitchen and dorm clean-up duty at camp is maintained by our students on a rotating basis.

Cost - \$1,500

This covers roundtrip airfare, meals, lodging at camp. This cost is tax-deductible. Cost for extra meals, spending money, and souvenirs is approximately \$125. The cost is tax-deductible.



Application Process- Student's Part

To apply, please submit the 2020 Service Trip Online Application. The 2020 Service Trip Application is for current full-time students only. The link to this application will be posted on the Student Portal under the "Alerts" section in the upper-right corner. Applications will only be accepted during the following time frame: Thursday, August 29, 3:00 p.m. through Wednesday, September 4, 12:30 p.m. (Note: The application will no longer be available after 12:30 p.m. on Wednesday, September 4).

Application Process- Parent's Part

In order for the student's application to be accepted, parents must read and agree to TKA's Service Trip Financial Policies. A link to these policies will be sent to parents when the application is submitted; parents must review these policies and submit agreement through the link provided by Wednesday, September 4, 10:00 p.m.

Selection Process

The team will consist of no more than 20 students, plus adult chaperones. After applications are submitted, participants will be interviewed and selected based on the following criteria: male/female ratio, previous service experience, and a singular vision for the trip. The Kentucky Service Trip will also weigh grade level in the selection process, with consideration given to seniors. All applicants will be notified by September 30, 2019.
