We will prepare to minister in a variety of ways including: helping directly in the classrooms, sports, and leading a school assembly. **At times, you may be a sole TKA representative in a classroom (depending on our numbers). So please be prepared to exhibit high energy, a good attitude, and a readiness to help the teacher in any way he or she may require.** This week is an important opportunity to continue building our partnership with San Miguel School **and showing the heart of Jesus with our actions** in a public school.

- To practice Christian service with actions rather than words
- To connect with families that live in our neighborhood
- To help students develop a passion and vision for local outreach and education.

Note: Students will be expected to help with at least one Friday Kids Club during lunch at San Miguel prior to the service week.

Food

Morning snack provided, students should bring a sack lunch and plan to spend lunch eating on site at San Miguel (no microwaves available).

Cost - \$175 (\$125 team supplies + \$50 donation for the 5th Grade Science Camp Fund)

Includes morning snacks, one team lunch, end of the week activity and sport supplies. The cost is tax-deductible.

Application Process

To apply, please submit the 2020 Service Trip Online Application. The 2020 Service Trip Application is for current full-time students only. The link to this application will be posted on the Student Portal under the "Alerts" section in the upper-right corner. Applications will only be accepted during the following time frame: Thursday, August 29, 3:00 p.m. through Wednesday, September 4, 12:30 p.m. (Note: The application will no longer be available after 12:30 p.m. on Wednesday, September 4).

Selection Process

The team will consist of 22 students and 4 adult chaperones. After applications are submitted, participants will be interviewed and selected based on the following trip-specific criteria: previous service experience, a heart for working with elementary age children (K-5th grade), patience, high-energy level, flexibility, creativity, and an interest in helping in a variety of ways, including inside and outside the classroom, playing games, and leading sports activities. Eight Spanish-speaking students are needed to work with the Spanish emergent program classes. For the San Miguel Service Week, priority will not automatically be given based on grade level. Students selected will be notified by September 30, 2019.
