



## Spain Service Trip: April 2-11, 2020

### Mission

The Spain Service Trip is open to TKA juniors and seniors. We will be serving with Colegio Alpha and Omega School in Denia. Colegio is the only protestant school in Spain serving the native population and has been doing so since 1961. We will be working with students at the school, helping them with their English, sharing the Gospel with the non-believers and encouraging our brothers and sisters in the faith.

### Goals

1. Help students of Colegio to further develop their English skills.
2. Share the Gospel to the 80% of students who do not yet believe.
3. Encourage the staff and students who are believers in a country that is spiritually dead.
4. Complete at least one labor project for the school

### Itinerary

April 2	Depart in the evening
April 3	Arrive in the evening and travel to Denia
April 4	Work on campus project
April 5	Attend local protestant church and visit town
April 6-9	Work with students and complete campus project
April 10	Spend the day in Madrid sightseeing
April 11	Travel home

### Accommodations/Food

The Center "Alfa & Omega" offers full board: breakfast, snack, lunch and dinner. The bedrooms (from 1 to 6 people) are in the House Residence. The toilets and showers are in the common area.

### Cost - \$1650

The cost for the trip includes round trip airfare from the Bay Area to Spain, ground transportation to and from Denia, lodging, meals, local excursions and service project supplies. Students are responsible for meals at airports, meals in Madrid, and personal spending money.

### Application Process- Student's Part

To apply, please submit the 2020 Service Trip Online Application. The 2020 Service Trip Application is for current full-time students only. The link to this application will be posted on the Student Portal under the "Alerts" section in the upper-right corner. Applications will only be accepted during the following time frame: Thursday, August 29, 3:00 p.m. through Wednesday, September 4, 12:30 p.m. (Note: The application will no longer be available after 12:30 p.m. on Wednesday, September 4).



### **Application Process- Parent's Part**

In order for the student's application to be accepted, parents must read and agree to TKA's Service Trip Financial Policies. A link to these policies will be sent to parents when the application is submitted; parents must review these policies and submit agreement through the link provided by Wednesday, September 4, 10:00 p.m.

### **Selection Process**

The team will consist of no more than 16 students and 3 adult chaperones. After applications are submitted, participants will be interviewed and selected based on the following criteria: spiritual maturity as we are traveling to a country that is spiritually dead, the ability to clearly explain the Gospel, a love for children, the ability to teach and connect with children, flexibility to live in a foreign culture with no desire to change the culture, having a teachable spirit, love for the Spanish culture. For the Spain trip, priority will not automatically be given based on grade level. All applicants will be notified by September 30, 2019.
