

Tulsa, OK Service Trip: April 1 - 7, 2023

Mission

We will partner with Praying Pelican Missions to travel to Tulsa, OK. Tulsa's culture is a mix of influences including a combination of Southwest, Midwest, and Southern regions, as well as a historical Native American presence. Settled in 1828 by the Lochapoka Band of the Creek Native American Tribe, Tulsa is located on Native American land, and we will be serving the Native American population.

Goals

Students will engage in a variety of ministry opportunities in support of local churches. Our primary church partner has individuals from 12 recognized tribes as part of their membership. This is an opportunity for students to learn about various Native American cultures, to grow in love and compassion for the people, and to engage in tangible acts of service.

Itinerary

April 1	Fly to Tulsa; be transported by Praying Pelican from the airport to our home base for the week
April 2 - 6	Serve 8:00 a.m. - 3 p.m.; dinner and evening programs/activities
April 7	Be transported by Praying Pelican to the airport; fly home

Housing

We will be staying in a bunkhouse with showers and bathrooms. Students will bring sleeping bags.

Food

Meals will include continental breakfast, bagged lunches, and home-cooked and restaurant dinners.

Cost - \$1500

This covers roundtrip airfare, van rental, meals, and lodging. Baggage fee for flights and food for meals on travel days (April 1 and April 7, 2023) may be a required additional expense.
