Anchorage, AK: We will travel with Praying Pelican Ministries, an organization that exists to build up, encourage, and assist the local Church in serving and reaching their communities for Christ. Students will participate in outreach activities primarily to sick, elderly individuals (visiting ministry) and the homeless population (soup kitchens, clothing pantries, etc).

Dinuba, CA: Gleanings for the Hungry provides food to mission organizations in 40 nations and is a ministry of YWAM, an organization whose purpose is to know God and to make Him known. Students will blend and pack rice, lentils, pasta and other dry ingredients to produce a nutritious soup mix. Students will also participate in maintenance and renovation of the facilities.

Kentucky: We will work with Christian Appalachian Project, an organization that serves people by building hope, transforming lives and sharing Christ's love. Students will assist families living in poverty with construction projects, landscaping, painting and cleaning.

Los Angeles, CA: We will travel to the Union Rescue Mission in Skid Row whose mission is to embrace people with the compassion of Christ. Students will participate in a variety of homeless outreach activities on Skid Row as well as service projects in the surrounding areas.

Lotus, CA: We will travel to Rock n Water, a Christian camp with the goal that youth and young adults might come to know Jesus. Students will serve with Angel Tree ministries serving children of inmates and will also participate in maintenance or renovation projects at the camp.

Navajo Nation, AZ: We will travel with Experience Mission, an organization that believes we were created to serve each other and share God's love by loving one another. Students will serve on the Reservation and participate in home and church repair projects, Kids Clubs, and church outreach programs.

San Francisco, CA: SF City Impact is a Christ centered organization located in the Tenderloin with the core values of loving God and loving your neighbor. Students will participate in food preparation and service, food packing and delivery to SRO's, street ministry, community outreach events, and prayer walks.

Seattle, WA: We will travel with Praying Pelican Ministries, an organization that exists to build up, encourage, and assist the local Church in serving and reaching their communities for Christ. Students will work with small church plants, serving the homeless in a variety of ways, and participating in street ministry.

Sunnyvale, CA: FMSC is a Christian organization called to feed God's starving children hungry in both body and spirit. Students will pack dry ingredient meals in the TKA gym Monday - Wednesday and will participate in a TBD service project on the TKA campus on Thursday.

Tecate, Mexico: Students will travel to Mexico to work on construction service projects. Plans are still TBD as we are working on rebuilding this trip this year.

Tulsa, OK: We will travel with Praying Pelican Ministries, an organization that exists to build up, encourage, and assist the local Church in serving and reaching their communities for Christ. We will be serving the Native American community, and students will participate in residential and church repairs, youth and kids outreach, and homeless ministry.
